Review FS Chapter 509, Part 1.

TEAMS A & G will report on what sections pertain to Administrative type matters, and be prepared to discuss those items with the rest of the class. For example, FS.509.035 gives the Division the right to close down a restaurant with severe public health issues. (Government perspective)

TEAMS B, E & F will report on what sections apply to or are applicable to the Hospitality Business entity, and to describe those rights, responsibilities, etc and affect on the business entity. EG - 509.111 - liability for guests property (Business perspective)

TEAMS C & D will report on what sections apply to or are applicable to or have a direct impact on the Public and to describe those rights, responsibilities and affect on the general public. EG - 509.111 - liability for guests property (Guest or Public Perspective)

Teams are to work separately, and will turn in a list at the beginning of class for your team as to what sections you are going to address in class. Each team will have about 15 minutes to report.

****NOTES for 4/26/assignments**

Note re Pg 180 - The Partners of Club Bravo have approached the Alpha Hotel, a new development on Clearwater Beach, wanting to lease space in the new hotel for a restaurant/nightclub. Team B are the Partners who have asked Prof Schuler from their old SPC Hospitality Law Class school days to arrange an appointment with the Alpha Team Managers to discuss what the Alpha Hotel wants to lease the space. Team A will start the discussions with an offer, to which Team B will respond, and we will go from there in hopes of making a deal before the meeting ends. The meeting is scheduled to last 30 minutes. Both parties are anxious to make a deal.

Notes re Pg 110 - All the questions on the page are appropriate to consider for both teams. The sales contract for the wedding provided for an arbitration clause in the case of dispute, and both sides have asked Professor Schuler and his Hospitality Law Class at SPC to serve as the arbitration panel. The Hotel Team will go first explaining the dilemma to the Guest Party and offering amends, realizing the tight economy we are in today. The Guest Party will respond to the offer and makes its best case for what they are seeking from the hotel. Professor Schuler has allocated 15 minutes to each side, which may be allocated between primary presentations and rebuttal time as the teams request.

Notes re Pg 84 - Attorney Schuler has a conglomerate of investors (the rest of the class) who are interested in opening this sub-type sandwich shop, and has asked this Hospitality Consulting Firm to make recommendations as to what sort of organizational and operating structure they would suggest to the group. The consultants will be free to ask Mr. Schuler questions about his clients that might be pertinent to the recommendations they make. Each consulting firm will have 15 minutes for their presentation.

Notes re Pg 60 - Team E is a widely respected lobbying firm in the Tampa Bay area that has been hired by the SPC Restaurant Association to represent them in front of the city council (the rest of the class) to address the proposed new liquor ordinance. The lobbyist team is renowned for its multi-member presentation approach. Mayor Schuler has allocated the lobbyists 15 minutes for their presentation. Questions from the Council may be anticipated.

All Students are expected to participate at some point in the team reports and presentations.
